### Studio Directions:

For some unknown reason to us (perhaps because we are located between two stream crossings, neither of which has a bridge) our address: 25 Bunker Hill Road, Ottsville, is not on GPS, nor is it on Google Maps. If Google Maps are used it will send you about 8 miles out of your way and you still will not get here. With GPS you will not go so far out of your way, but you will still not get here.

1. Best to get to Ottsville and take Geigel Hill Road one mile to the stop sign. (Geigel Hill Road comes off of Durham Road in Ottsville and does not meet Route 611, although that is hard to tell from some maps). If GPS or Google Maps are used, put in 684 Geigel Hill Road.
2. Go past 684 Geigel Hill Road 3/10 of a mile to the stop sign.
3. Make a left turn onto Clay Ridge Road. (At this point Geigel Hill Road is making a 90 degree bend to the right, so when making the left turn you will barely have to turn the steering wheel.)
3. You will be on Clay Ridge Road FOR NO MORE THAN 5 SECONDS.
4. Make a left turn onto Bunker Hill Road, which is a dirt road. There is no road sign for Bunker Hill Road. (For Bucks Fever we will have your signs out.)
5. Go 1/4 mile to the stream.
6. Drive through the stream. It is easy and almost all cars can easily make it unless a huge rain has recently fallen, in which case, call for alternative directions, which involve driving to a neighbor's property and walking in two-and-a half minutes.
7. Go 100 yards past the stream to an unmarked driveway on the left. If you miss the driveway you will come to another stream crossing. We are the only driveway between the stream crossings.
8. Drive up the hill, through the woods and into a field. Go straight back to the parking area by a barn-type garage.
9. Walk up the steps that are straight ahead to the buildings.
